

PLEASINGTON GARDENS OF REMEMBRANCE & DARWEN CEMETERY MEMORIAL WEDGE

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Wedge spaces will be allocated strictly in order, within your chosen plot, and the next available space will be allocated to you
- The memorial wedge space is leased to you for a period of 20 years
- The Council reserves the right to vary or refuse any inscription that is considered unsuitable
- The applicant should inform Bereavement Services of any change of address, or in case of the death of the owner, please let us have your details if you wish to take over responsibility for the lease
- Approximately 3 months before the expiry of the lease period, a renewal offer will be sent to the applicant currently on record (whether that be the original applicant or his/her successor)
- Please note that all fees and charges increase annually
- If you choose not to renew the lease within the prescribed time scale, the wedge will be removed from display
- The wedge will be retained for a period of one year after removal. During this time you may arrange to collect the wedge. Alternatively you will still be able to arrange a further lease period, on the understanding that the wedge may not go back in its original location if that space has been re-sold in the meantime
- After one year in storage, the Council will dispose of the wedge
- You may place flowers in the holder provided at any time, and additionally, a wreath may be placed by the wedge at Christmas if desired. **No other personalisation will be permitted** as we must maintain a neat and tidy appearance on the plots. We do not wish to cause distress, but any cards or statues or other memorabilia left by the memorial will be removed without prior notification.
